A System of Airports

- Vast network of 66 public-use airports licensed by DOAV
 - 9 Commercial Service
 - 8 Reliever
 - 19 Regional
 - 16 Community
 - 14 Local Service
- Infrastructure needs coordinated w/ DOAV & FAA
 - Virginia Air Transportation System Plan (VATSP)
 - National Plan of Integrated Airport Systems (NPIAS)
- Virginia Aviation Board (VAB)



Legislative Priorities

- HB446: Abandoned or derelict aircraft; disposal.
 - Provides the authority for an airport sponsor to address these situations
 - Provides prescriptive measures that save time and money
 - Mirrors existing policies for vehicles and watercraft
 - Ensures airports being used for aeronautical purposes
- VAOC is a resource for lawmakers to understand impacts of state/federal policy on airports


